- Let your Program Manger or Managing Director know that you'd like a Donate Page and they'll work with our accounting staff to get the HTML code.
- 2. Make sure your website is secure with a SSL certificate. Some web hosts, like WIX, include the SSL in its monthly fee.
 - Hint: your website is secure if your website reads https:// in the URL.
- 3. Paste your HTML code in the backend of your website. If you need help embedding the code, email Robin Rueff.
