How to add fonts to your font book

Download the logo's zip file and unzip it. Go to Finder > Applications > Font Book.

Once Font Book opens, go to 'File' and click 'Add Fonts.'



Select the font folder you want to upload to the Font Book. Click 'Open.'

Once installed, the new fonts should be available to most apps right away. If not, you may need to quit and relaunch the app. If all else fails, restart your Mac to ensure that everything recognizes the new fonts.
