District 215 Receives 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Center Grant

**(Calumet City, IL) – November 28, 2012:** Thornton Fractional High School District 215 applied for and received a one-time \$134,000 grant award from the Illinois State Board of Education for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Center Program for the 2012-2013 school year. The district may apply for an additional two years of funding through the program upon sufficient progress of grant mandated activities.

The purpose of the grant is to provide academic, artistic, and cultural enrichment opportunities for students and their families.
