## **HOW BLESSINGS STARTED**

In 2005, Missy Hammerstrom was visiting an elementary school in Louisville, KY., for a community project. She was eating lunch when a little girl asked for Missy's apple. Missy asked the girl if she didn't eat enough in the lunchroom. The girl said, "No I'm taking it home so I can eat it this weekend." Missy was heartbroken by the thought that kids in her community were going hungry. That night she drove to the store and purchased every backpack that she could find. She filled those backpacks with food and donated them to the school. That weekend, Missy fed 30 kids and Blessings in a Backpack was born. Today, Blessings in a Backpack is a nationally known organization, feeding over 88,000 kids on the weekends throughout the weekend in 44 states.
